

# Kew Riverside Policy for Rubbish & Recycling

The rubbish and recycling collection day for Kew Riverside is Monday morning. All Bank Holiday arrangements are posted on the LBRUT Website <u>http://www.richmond.gov.uk/services/waste\_and\_recycling</u>

For Freehold and Leasehold Houses

All house owners are responsible for managing their own waste bins and ensuring LBRUT empty your green bins and recycling containers.

The following collections are made every week:

# **General Waste**

Please make sure your green bins are positioned adjacent to your property and NOT left on the roadside. The waste operatives don't always return the bin to the property, and you may have to recover your own bin; please do so immediately the bin is emptied. Your bin needs to have a fully secured lid without cracks in the main body; this attracts vermin, foxes and scavenging birds.

# Recycling

Residents should recycle using the containers provided. LBRUT provide blue and black boxes for recycling as well as special containers for recycling food waste. If you do not have these already, please order them.

### Food waste

Your caddies must be sealed so please ensure the lid can fully close. Your food waste caddy will not be emptied if it contains any items that cannot be recycled. Caddies are available from LBRUT.

Blue Box Recycling Mixed paper and cardboard Including clean paper, card and cardboard, envelopes, junk mail, cartons (e.g. Tetra Pak)

**Black Box Recycling** 

Plastics, cans and bottles

Including plastic bottles, pots, tubs, trays, unbroken glass bottles and jars, food tins, drink cans, foil, empty aerosol cans

Please make sure your all your box recycling is covered and protected from the wind and vermin. Any broken caddies and boxed can be recycled at the same time as the rubbish collection, just leave by the kerbside with your normal waste.

### Garden Waste

Garden waste collections are made fortnightly.

You can either use the LBRUT subscription service or buy garden sacks and book a collection when you need it. Check the LBRUT site to confirm your collection date.

Please do not dump your garden waste beside the riverside entrances to the towpath either on the towpath or on Kew Riverside.

Dog owners please used the dog waste bins on site or take your dog waste home and never throw your dog waste bags into the gardens.
